

## **US EPA Regulations and Funding**

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations call for new school buses to meet stricter emissions standards beginning with model year 2007. The requirements call for reducing particulate matter (PM) and hydrocarbon (HC) emissions by 90%. Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) also will be reduced by an equal amount during a phase-in period from 2007 to 2010.

The US EPA has also directed that Ultra-Low-Sulfur Diesel (ULSD) fuel be produced and available, beginning in the summer of 2006.

The technology solutions for reducing emissions are available today. And, funding for retrofit programs is growing. Come to the NAPT Foundation Workshop to learn more.

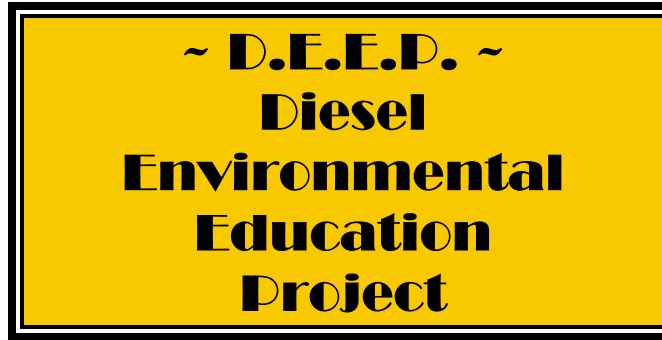
